Discussion points:

Dam -State notified us that we are going to be inspected this year. Repairs are needed to be done prior to inspection.

- Repair and paint the water shut off valve.
- Corners of spillway need to be caulked.
- Dave Chalifoux will be asking Lloyd for information pertaining to past dam repairs and any relevant history.
- Make sure these repairs are accounted for in the budget. Perhaps a line item for any future Dam repairs should be added.

- We all agreed their findings and recommendations should be followed; we hope to hear from them soon.
- Lake Bottom Blankets were discussed regarding size, pricing and ease of use. These would be used as a method of weed control. Dale Fiore to ask vendor for a demo.
- York Rakes were discussed as an additional remedy to assist in removing muck from the beach areas. We have two privately owned rakes that we will experiment with. Thanks to David Chalifoux and Dale Fiore.
- Jay Cassella will be looking into a past interested party that may still be willing to remove any muck we gather from the lake, at no cost to the association.
- An application for a permit to treat for weed control should be applied for prior to springtime.
- Dale Fiore will seek a quote for chemical treatment from The Pond Connection to have on hand.
- There is a need to schedule a spring clean up day/weekend. Many volunteers are needed.
