

Bylaw Section to be Changed: Section 49 – Garbage and Litter - Draft

Section as Currently Written:

GARBAGE AND LITTER

Section 49. It shall be unlawful for any owner, lessee, or tenant of any premises to dispose of garbage, refuse, litter, discarded utensils or furniture by depositing such on either private or public property or on any highway or street within the boundary of the Hidden Lake corporate limits, or by casting such materials into the lake or on its shores or beaches.

Suggested Replacement Section:

We would like to append Section 49A and 49B to GARBAGE AND LITTER

Section 49A Garbage/Recycling Cans. Homeowners are responsible for the proper quality and type of trash, yard waste, and recycling containers. Garbage must be kept in a garbage can or receptacle.

Section 49B Compost Piles. No compost piles shall be allowed. The use of a contained box designed and manufactured for organic compost containment may be used in the backyard, out of sight from the street

Reason for the Replacement:

- We are in a rural area, where wildlife is prevalent. Due to this we want garbage to be kept in garbage cans. Bags can easily be torn into by wildlife.
- People can organic garden using compost but we want to keep any odors from those activities from being a nuisance to others.
